She was a caring person who always greeted everyone with a smile. Even though she was unable to play this past summer, she never missed a rehearsal or a concert. She would bring her husband David and made sure he was all set to play. Lynda helped with fundraising and sold 50/50 tickets during the concerts throughout last year.

Lynda had optimism and a positive spirit even though she wasn't feeling well. She always had a contagious smile, a friendly word, and a positive attitude. To honor Lynda and her years of service, we have engraved a brick at the band shell in her memory. She was an important part of our family and she will be missed.
